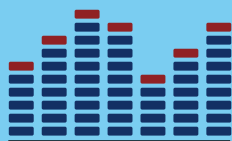

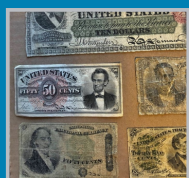


SERIALS
