RE: RAILS Online Database Proposal

## **Background**

The Reaching Across Illinois Library System (RAILS) developed a legislative proposal for statewide database access. The <u>proposal</u> was introduced at their March 26, 2021 board meeting.

The proposal would apply to all Illinois residents regardless of access to library services and included a \$5M estimated annual cost in addition to library system funding. It was filed in May 2021 as <u>HB 4092</u>. The database proposal is currently assigned to committee, and RAILS is working with Senator Laura Murphy.

## **Illinois Library Association Public Policy Committee**

The Illinois Library Association's Public Policy Committee (PPC) did consider this proposal as a possible legislative priority for the organization last fall. The proposal was not chosen as a priority for ILA. As you may recall, ILA selected <a href="two priorities">two priorities</a> for the legislative year: Broadband, and e-Book Pricing.

## **Current Activity**

RAILS board and members remain committed to the proposal and are considering what the next steps are.
