SHARE & Dream Grant Report

The SHARE staff and committees are working on a variety of tasks, including training for SHARE full members and transitional libraries; developing the new SHARE Operational Guidelines, which will include all of the SHARE policies and procedures that will be posted on the SHARE website; reviewing fees for membership, bibliographic services, and implementation; writing grants and grant proposals; responding to help tickets, emails, and phone questions; collecting data from member libraries for FY17 (annual membership agreements); assisting transitional members as they prepare to go live on Polaris, as well as following up with new members who are now live on Polaris; conducting weekly SHARE Chat sessions; and developing a database that will contain all information on participating libraries.
