SHARE Monthly Report

SHARE staff and committees are working on generating ideas, practices and procedures to decrease expenditures, as well as increase revenue. SHARE staff have submitted two grant proposals to the Institute for Museum and Library Services, and continue to search for additional grant opportunities to apply for.

At present, SHARE consists of 331 library agencies, with 474 library buildings. Of those members, 69 are Transitional members. We project that we can add five additional transitional libraries with the funds remaining in the Dream Grant.
