

Summary of 2014 Election Results:

Voting was open from March 15 to February 15.

145 ballots were cast.

Of the total responses 4 had duplicates, in which a legitimate voter cast 2 ballots. In 3 of the 4 cases, 1 of the duplicates was incomplete. In each of these instances a member logged in, never cast a vote, and then returned to the voting process to create another ballot that they completed on the second log-in. Because there were no votes cast in the initial log-in, their duplicates did not factor into the final tally.

In the 1 other duplicate case, both ballots were identical. This resulted in 1 less vote for Sandra West, Alayna Davies-Smith and Valerie Green. While the tally changed by 1 in 3 of the races, it did not change the overall election results.

Election Results:

Academic Library Representative Slate: Sandra West wins the seat with 74 votes, vs. Spencer Michael Brayton, with 63 votes

School Library Representative Slate: Rachel Fuller wins the seat with 75 votes, vs. Alayna Davies Smith, with 62 votes

Public Library Trustee Slate: Valerie Green with 135 votes

Public Library Trustee Write-in Slate: Gary Denué wins the seat with 8 votes vs. the following candidates who had one vote each – Loretta Broomfield, Teri Rankin, Stacie Henderson, Allen Lanham, Amy Ihnen, Dick Helton, Joyce Casper, Anita Driver

>>>> UNCONFIRMED RESULT: Special Library Representative Write –in Slate: Nina Pals wins seat with 2 votes vs. Karen Perrin, who also had 2 votes but declined the nomination, and Betsy Mahoney and Jane Ehrenhart, who each had 1 vote.

I spoke with Gary Denué, who is still eligible to serve and willing to serve.

I also spoke with Karen Perrin Wednesday evening. She declined the nomination.
